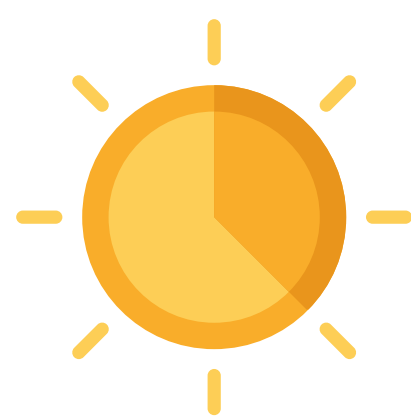

Personal protective equipment usage was high for all types of logging



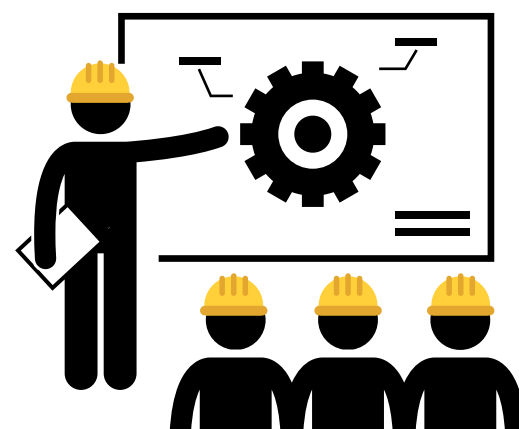
Workday

For both mechanized and conventional, the larger the company, the more likely to have safety training

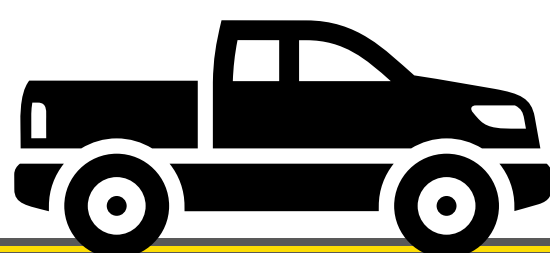

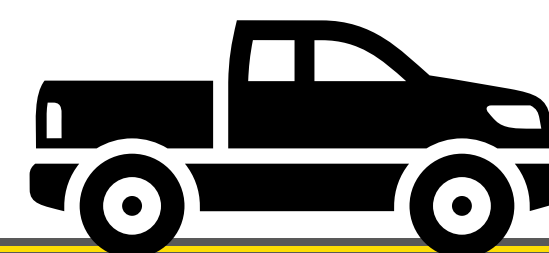


The majority of loggers have emergency action plans for each worksite

Conventional 40.9 minutes



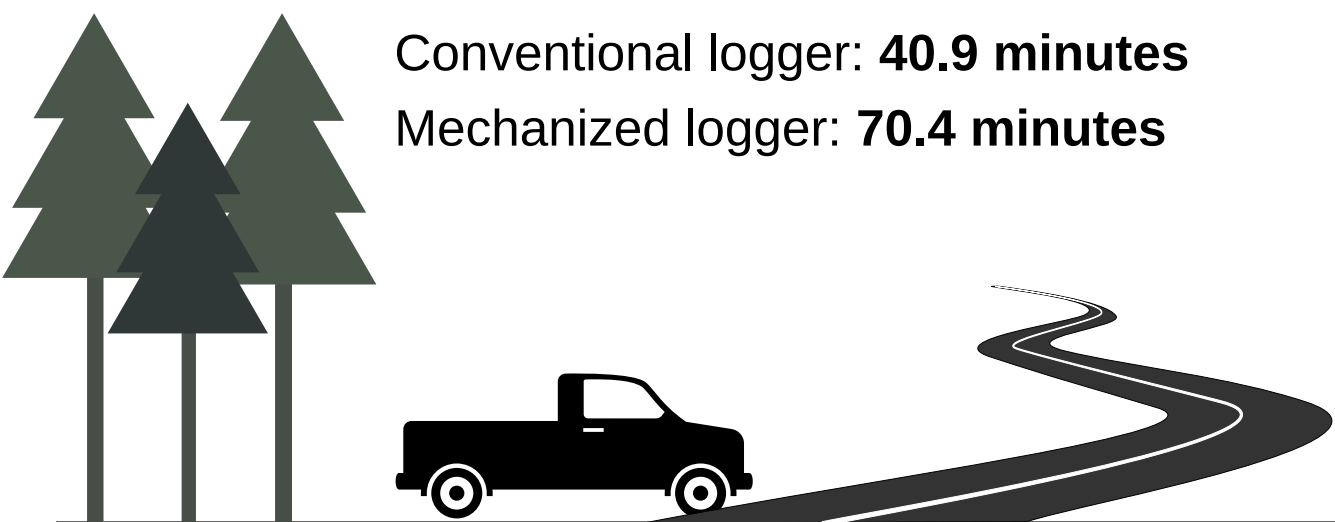

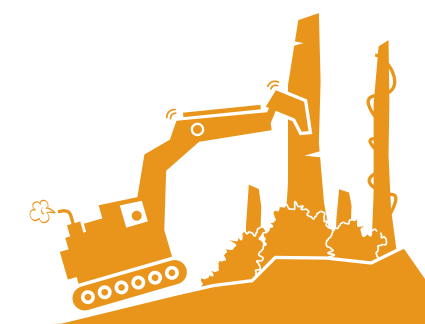

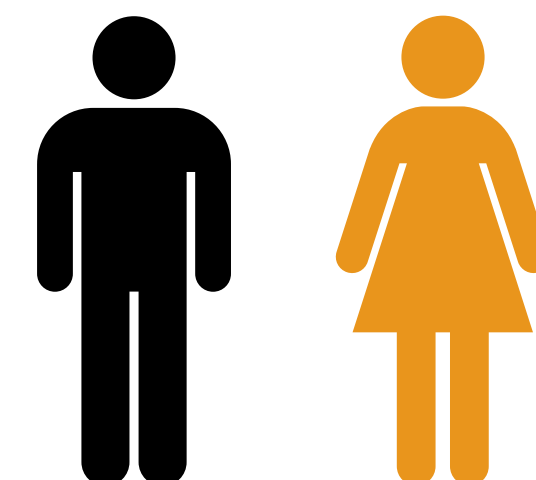

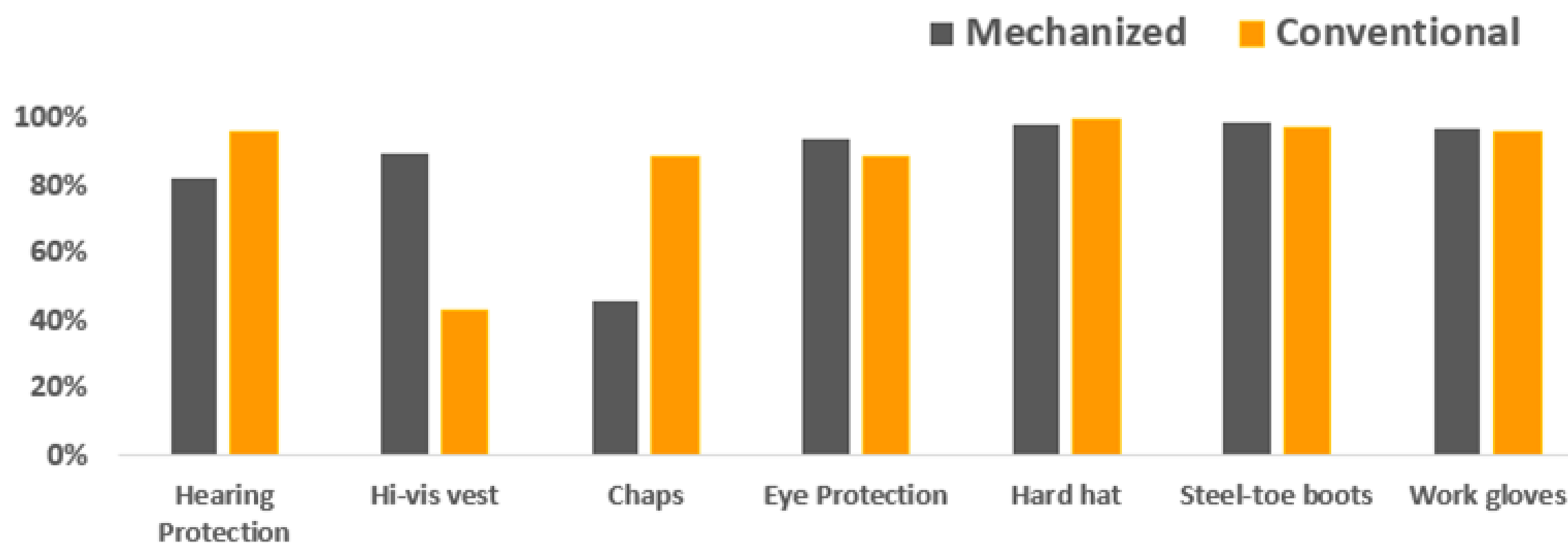
