## Protect Your Employees During Covid-19



### Employees Take Temperatures

- Employees can take their own temperature (which helps ensure social distancing) ideally before or as soon as they arrive to work.
- Confirm that their temperature is less than 100.4F (38.0C), and they are not displaying Covid-19 symptoms (see below).

**OR**

### Employers Take Temperatures

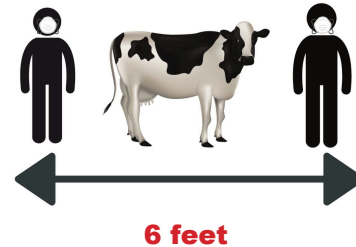
- If an employer is taking temperatures, set up a physical barrier, such as a glass or plastic window
- Wear disposable gloves
- Check temperatures by reaching around partition; stay behind barrier at all times.
- Temperatures should be less than 100.4F (38.0C).
- Ask about and observe for Covid-19 symptoms (see below)

**Remember: Use a clean pair of gloves for each employee and thoroughly disinfect the thermometer after each check.**



### Practice Social Distancing

Always maintain 6 feet of distance.



### Use Proper Hygiene and PPE

- At the start, during and after work, all employees should wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- PPE should be used when people are working together, such as eye protection, gloves, face coverings, and face shields



## COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. If employees have any of these symptoms or a temperature over 100.4 degrees, send them home and have them contact your county department of health for testing
